The age mentioned in Column "C" is 18 as per above example, So the age of child as on 01.04.2021 is 18. Similarly if the Date of birth of child is 12.09.2003 i.e the child is born between 2nd April to 31st December. For calculating the complete age of child as on 01.04.2021, the row having year 2003 will refer in Column "B" of the table. The age mentioned in Column "C" is 17 as per above example, so the age of child as on 01.04.2021 is 17. The age of child must be filled in the table after accurate calculation. The class wise number of students must be filled in table after writing the complete age year in Class Attendance Register as per calculation.
