- 5. At the Zonal level, the winner teams, one each from boys and girls categories, will be given cash prizes of

1st Prize 10,000/ 2nd Prize 7,000/ 3rd Prize 5,000/-

Best selected 02 Teams at State level competitions viz. one each of boys and girls, shall participate in the Zonal level competition.
