Online applications are invited from female candidates only for filling up of 23 posts of TGTs for Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas purely on contractual basis at a consolidated remuneration of Rs. 20000/- per month initially for a period of one year and extendable on yearly basis on performance basis & subject to continuation of the scheme in Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad, Haryana for direct recruitment through the website www.recruitment-portal.in. The online application can be filled up from 24.09.2019 at 10.00 AM up to 15.10.2019 till 5.00 PM, thereafter, website link will be disabled. The candidates are strongly advised to apply online well in time without waiting for last date of submission of online application. The candidates are required to bring the printed copies of the online application form with necessary certificates at the time of verification of documents.

Haryana School Shiksha Pariyojna Parishad (HSSPP) is a society under the aegis of Department of School Education, Haryana. It is responsible for implementing Samagra Shiksha in the State. HSSPP is running Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs) residential Schools for girls under Samagra Shiksha in 32 Educationally Backward Blocks (EBBs) of the State. Essential qualifications (EQ) for the above posts are as under:

- I. **Essential qualifications for the post of TGT S.ST/English:-**
 - (i) B.A/B.Com and 2 years Diploma in Elementary Education; **OR**
B.A/B.Com with at least 50% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed) **OR**
B.A/B.Com with at least 45% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education(B.Ed), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition norms and procedure) Regulations issued from time to time in this regard; **OR**
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed): **OR**
Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years B.A/B.Com.Ed); **OR**
B.A/B.Com at least 50% marks and 1 year B.Ed (Special Education);
 - (ii) In case of B.A/B.Com, in addition to English, a combination of at least two subjects with at least 50% marks in aggregate individually in the subjects during all the years of study out of the following:-
 - (1) History
 - (2) Political Science
 - (3) Economics
 - (4) Geography
 - (5) Sociology
 - (6) Psychology

Note: At least History or Geography should have been for all the three years of Graduation.

- (iii) In case of B.Ed., Social Studies as a teaching subject from a recognized university;
- (iv) Certificate of having qualified Haryana Teacher Eligibility Test (HTET)/ school teachers Eligibility test (STET) of level-2 in the relevant subject.
- (v) Matric with Hindi/Sanskrit or 10+2/B.A/M.A with Hindi as one of the subject.

II. Essential qualifications for the post for TGT Sanskrit/Hindi :-

- (i) B.A. with at least 50% marks in Sanskrit as an elective subject and 2 years Diploma in Elementary Education ; **OR**

B.A. with at least 50% marks as well as in Sanskrit as an elective subject and 1 year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed); **OR**

B.A. with at least 45% marks as well as 50% marks in Sanskrit as an elective subject and 1 year Bachelor in Education(B.Ed), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulation issued from time to time in this regard ; **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed); **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 years BA Ed; **OR**

B.A. with at least 50% marks as well as in Sanskrit as an elective subject and 1 year B.Ed (Special Education);

- (ii) In case of B.Ed Sanskrit as a teaching subject form a Recognized university;
- (iii) Certificate of having qualification Haryana Teacher Eligibility Test (HTET)/School Teachers Eligibility (STET) of level-2 in the relevant subject.
- (iv) Matric with Hindi/Sanskrit or 10+2/B.A/M.A with Hindi as one of the subject.

III. Essential qualifications for the post for TGT Science/Math :-

- (i) B.Sc. and 2 year Diploma in Elementary Education; **OR**

B.Sc. with at least 50% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education (B.Ed) **OR**

B.Sc. with at least 45% marks and 1 year Bachelor in Education(B.Ed.), in accordance with the NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations issued from time to time in this regard; **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year Bachelor in Elementary Education (B.El.Ed): **OR**

Senior Secondary (or its equivalent) with at least 50% marks and 4 year B.Sc.Ed)

OR

B.Sc. with at least 50% marks and 1 year B.Ed (Special Education);

- (ii) In case of B.Sc., a combination of at least three subjects in which Mathematics should be compulsory subject out of the following:-

- (1) Physics
- (2) Chemistry
- (3) Botany
- (4) Zoology
- (5) Mathematics

Note:- In case of Hons. Degree, in any of the above mentioned subjects, the candidate must have studied other two subjects (one subject should be mathematics) in the first and second year of course.

- (iii) In case of B.Ed., Science as a teaching subject from a recognized university;
- (iv) Certificate of having qualified Haryana Teacher Eligibility Test (HTET)/ School Teachers Eligibility Test (STET) (Math should be one in the teaching subject) of level-2 in the relevant subject;
- (v) Matric with Hindi/Sanskrit or 10+2/B.A./M.A with Hindi as one of the Subject.

The final selection will be made on the basis of selection criteria given below:

* Note: If a candidate attain 76% marks in any given exam her weightage will be as 7.6 (i.e.0.1x 76=7.6).			
In case female candidates have done both M.Phil. & Ph.D. the number will be given only for Ph.D.			
In case of two or more female candidates are having same score for a single post as per selection criteria, then a candidate senior in age shall be given preference.			

Special Instructions:

1. **Age:** The age limit for the said posts is between 18-42 years as on the closing date of application.

Relaxation in Age:

In the case of candidates belonging to the SC/ BCA/BCB/ESM/EWS/ESP and PwD (persons with disabilities) and Widow/Divorcee etc. the upper age limit shall be such as may be fixed by the Govt. of Haryana from time to time.

The upper age limit in respect of widow, divorcee, Legally Separated woman, deserted woman and unmarried woman will be upto 47 years as per Govt. Instructions.

2. **Pay Scale:** The incumbents will be appointed on a consolidated remuneration of Rs. 20,000/-per month.
3. **Application fees (non-refundable)** amounting to Rs. 250/- for female candidates of Haryana State and Rs. 500/- for other State Female Candidates. In case, at the time of verification of documents, it is found that certificates are not valid, their candidature will be rejected and fees of such candidate will be forfeited.

4. Female candidates applying for a post must ensure that they fulfil all the eligibility conditions on the date of advertisement. If it is found at the time of document verification that the candidates do not fulfil any of the eligibility condition or it is found that the information furnished is false or incorrect in that case their candidature will be cancelled.
5. The benefit of reservation will be given only to those SC/BCA/BCB/ESM/EWS/ESP & PwD (persons with disabilities) candidates who are domicile of Haryana State.
6. The candidates from reserved categories are required to submit SC/BCA/BCB/ESM/EWS/ESP & PwD (persons with disabilities) Certificate duly issued by the competent authority at the time of document verification. Likewise the eligible Sports Person shall be required to submit the sport gradation certificate as per Government instructions duly issued by the competent authority. DESM shall be required to submit the fresh Eligibility Certificate duly issued by the respective Zila Sainik Board.
7. Female candidate must bring her all original documents along with a set of self-attested copies of the documents at the time of document verification otherwise she will not be allowed for the same.
8. The Parishad reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of vacancies and to change the vacancy station or to withdraw the advertisement at any point of time. The Parishad may also cancel the process of selection of teachers at any stage without assigning any reasons.
